Choose 3 buildings that you like and follow the instructions of the tasks below...

Enjoy your adventure!

EXPLORATION 1 – MACRO

Look all around you at the buildings on a large scale.
Which ones attract you? Take some photos of three buildings and note their locations.

EXPLORATION 2 – MESO

Now move closer and look at the shapes of doorways, the windows, roofs, etc. of your chosen buildings above. Take some photos.

EXPLORATION 3 – MICRO

Move in super close and look at the details of these buildings. Look at the doorways, windows, walls etc. What patterns and shapes can you see?
Take some photos.

- List the colours you'd like to see in your city.
